



Impartiality:

DAS the resource of DAS Certification is fully aware of need of impartiality, conflict of intrest & confidentiality, to maintain impartiality and the perception of impartiality DAS Certification will base all certification decisions on objective evidence of conformity and nonconformity and not allow those decisions to be influenced by other parties. The top management commits to the principle of impartiality & confidentiality and uses it as guidance for decision of certifiction activities and ensures that actions will be taken to identify, control, mitigat the activities that present threats to Impartiality.

For this purpose impartiality committee is formulated ensuring balance of interests from all stake holders.

Confidentiality:

- DAS Certification makes arrangements to safeguard the confidentiality of the information obtained or created during the performance of Certification activities at all levels of its structure, including committees and external bodies or individuals acting on its behalf, through legally enforceable undertaking (Declaration of Independence, Impartiality, Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality statement FMP08/02).
- DAS Certification informs the persons, in advance, of the information it tends to place in the public domain. All other information, except for information that is made publicly accessible by the client, is considered confidential. Reffer to the procedure for imformation mamangment DAS-P-08



DAS Certification ensures that:

- b. All documents and computer data containing information relating to the certification process are kept in a secure environment all times, to maintain confidentiality and prevent damage or deterioration.

- d. DAS Certification will not put the complaint in public domain without the consent of client & complainant unless it is legally required to make it available in public domain.
